Vendors must be registered as a service provider with the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Federal Communications Commission, have a Service Provider Identification Number (SPIN), and comply with all SLD service provider requirements. The vendor shall give its ERATE SPIN number in its proposal. Vendors on Louisiana State Contract should provide the State Contract Number on the proposal. All vendors submitting proposals must carefully read and abide by the Eligible Services List on the Schools & Libraries Web site: http://www.sl.universalservice.org/reference/eligible.asp
